Vice-President George Bush noted that while ten pounds of potatoes had risen to \$1.74, he said that the American public had, in 1982, more buying power than ever before.

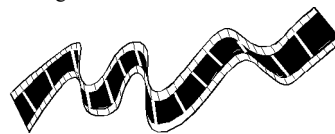
